UPCOMING RALLIES October 1 - 5, 2010, Balloon Fiesta Rally, Albuquerque NM



UPCOMING RALLIES October 6 - 11, Region 11 Rally, Gallup NM

RED ROCK PARK, with elevation from 6600 to 7000 feet and encompassing 640 acres, has a large campground equipped with electric and water hookups, picnic areas, restrooms and showers. The spectacular red cliffs which frame the Park on three sides began formation 205 million years ago, during the Mesozoic era, sometimes referred to as the Age of the Dinosaurs. Several archeological sites in the Park record the presence of the Anasazi, a prehistoric farming culture which developed and persisted in the area from 300 to 1200 AD. From 1700 to the present, the region has been sparsely inhabited by the Navajo Indians.

Red Rock Park, situated in Indian Country. is the gateway to Zuni, one of the Seven Cites of Cibola sought by Coronado and the Conquistadors; Acoma, the sky city, one of the oldest inhabited cities in the United States; Old Laguna Pueblo and its Spanish church; the Hopi Reservation; and the Navajo and El Morro are among the National Monuments within a two hour drive from Red Rock Park. Petrified Forest National Park, the Ice Caves beneath Lava Badlands with temperatures of 31 degrees year round, the incomparable views of the badland formations known as the Painted Desert are all natural wonders that shouldn't be missed when exploring the Gallup area.

PARKING RESERVATIONS

Parking is \$15.00 per night with water and electric. (This is separate from the Rally Fee and paid directly to the park.) Dump sites are available within the park.

You will need to make your own reservations by calling Red Rock Park at 505 722-3839.

Restrooms and showers are available. To park nearby the restrooms or handicap, make your request known when making your reservations.

## UPCOMING RALLIES October 15 - 17, 2010 Pumkin Chunkin Rally, Estancia NM



Pumkin Chunkin (officially known as the Estancia Pumpkinfest) is the event of the year in the small New Mexico town of Estancia. Last year was the first time there was an Airstream Rally in connection with this event and it was a great success!

Starting Friday October 15, we will set up camp at the Torrance County Fairgrounds. Saturday morning those who want to can decorate their rigs and parade through town among the fire engines, vintage cars, horses, and other floats and groups. If you don't particularly care for being IN the parade, you

can walk from camp to WATCH the parade!

The Pumkins are chunked by various "chunkers" ranging from slingshot contraptions, trebuchets, to giant semi trailer-sized cannons. Saturday evening there will be a dinner at a local restaurant. A pot luck breakfast will be held on Sunday morning. If you want to explore the area, there are historical towns, Pueblo ruins, and National Forest. Estancia is just a short jog from Albuquerque or Santa Fe.

- No showers.

- This year the Rotary Club may use this building Saturday morning for a public fundraiser breakfast.
- An individual parade entry form is optional. I will register as a group. The parade is pretty informal.
