Deadline for your registration is Aug 25. This is a WBCCI rally. If you are not a member of WBCCI, but own an Airstream, and would like to attend as a Guest, please contact the hosts. Here are the plans...

Thursday night 5:30 Welcome Happy Hour at the Group Area. Bring your beverage and a snack to share.

Friday morning at 9:00 we head down to Diaz Farms where our families have been buying their chile for 50 years. Eddie Diaz will take us into the field and pass on some chile wisdom and answer questions. You can purchase chile and have it roasted while we are there. We have made arrangements for a commercial freezer to be available for any of you who want to freeze your chile for the trip home. www.diazfarms.com

Friday night Happy Hour at the Group Area at 5:00. Bring your beverage and a snack to share. For those who want to join us will be heading 7 miles north for dinner in Pinos Altos at the Buckhorn Saloon and Opera House. The Buckhorn is quite something to see. What you eat and drink is on you but we can all sit together in one of the dining rooms with rich history and amazing artifacts on the walls. Pinos Altos was a thriving metropolis in the mid 1800's, now a small community with a fun outlaw past. www.buckhornsaloonandoperahouse.com

Saturday, if you are up for a easy hike, we can head up to the Gila Cliff Dwellings about 40 miles and 2 hours away. Leaving at 9:00am again. The hiking trail from the Cliff Dweller Canyon up to the Gila Cliff Dwellings will let you explore the natural environment that sustained Tularosa Mogollon families and were once their home. www.nps.gov/gicl We are planning to have box lunches made at Diane's bakery. They are \$10 if you are interested. The drive to the dwellings is through the Gila Wilderness. Leaving the dwellings you can come back the way you came or complete the Trail of the Mountain Spirits Scenic Byway which takes you through Mimbres and the Santa Rita open pit mine

Saturday Night Happy Hour at 5:30 and dinner is open to enjoy one of the great restaurants in Silver City or stay in. Your choice.

Each morning there will be coffee with donuts and fruit in the group area. Early Bird Tom Kirk will have that going by 6:30. Sunday is "Happy Trails Day" but stop and have coffee and say Adios.

The Rally fee is \$10 per person payable when we see you in Silver City. It doesn't include dinner at the Buckhorn or the Saturday box lunch both of which you just pay for at the Rally.

Rose Valley RV Ranch has reserved their dry camping Rally area for us, along with the event area and 10 spots for full hookups. For dry camping you are welcome to use a generator. You need to call them to reserve a spot at (575) 534-4277. Camping fees are discounted 20% for the Rally. Dry camping is \$15 per night. Back-in sites and Pull-thru sites are \$27.50 and \$30.40 per night, respectively. For those of us dry camping there is a dump station for us to use prior to heading home. Fresh water, bathrooms, and showers also provided. Just in case your Airstream is not feeling up to travel, Rose Valley also has casitas you can rent. Let the office know if that interests you. www.rosevalleyrv.com

If you would like to come in to Rose Valley a few days early or stay past Sunday just let the folks in the office know when you call to make your reservations.
